



HOT WEATHER POLICY

1. TRAINING

- It is Jags policy that if it is 35 degrees or above at 5pm on a training night, training will be cancelled in the interest of player safety.
- Please listen to radio news broadcasts at 5pm on hot days to get the current temperature.
- Players/Parents are to contact their Coach if uncertain whether or not training is being held.

2. GAMES

- The decision to cancel games due to hot weather are made by Netball SA in accordance with their guidelines (refer www.netballsa.asn.au).
- If games are cancelled coaches will be notified by the NJNC Secretary.
- Coaches will be responsible for notifying the players in their team.

3. SUMMER, TUESDAY AND FRIDAY NIGHT COMPETITIONS

3.1 Friday Night Competition

- When the temperature is 36 degrees or higher as announced on 5AA at 1.00pm all matches will be CANCELLED.
- When the temperature is between 34 degrees and 36 degrees as announced on 5AA at 1.00pm matches will start as follows:
 - ❖ Matches due to start at 7.00pm will start at 7.30pm and matches due to start at 8.00pm will start at 8.30pm.
 - ❖ Quarters will be reduced for the Juniors to 12 minute quarters.
 - ❖ More drink breaks will be allowed but the clock is not to be stopped and no coaching is allowed.

3.2 Tuesday Night Competition

- When the temperature is 36 degrees or higher as announced on 5AA at 1.00pm all matches will be CANCELLED.
- When the temperature is between 34 degrees and 36 degrees as announced on 5AA at 1.00pm quarters will be reduced to 12 minutes each.
- More drink breaks will be allowed but the clock is not to be stopped and no coaching is allowed.
