## CLUB DEVELOPMENTS

The Newton Jaguars Netball Club Management Committee are committed to the future development of our State League Club.

The club does not have a home base, and as such is segmented, the State League squad train at a facility in the CBD, the Juniors train at Windsor Gardens and Seniors have trained at Athol Park. None of these facilities provide us with a clubhouse or storage facility.

The Newton Jaguars Netball Club are keen to establish a headquarters and additional playing facilities. Discussions are in progress with the East Torrens District Cricket Club (ETDCC) for the potential development of the Campbelltown Memorial Oval (cnr North East & Darley Roads, Paradise) into a community sporting hub, including the development of floodlit netball courts and all weather cricket nets in the north western corner of the oval precinct.

The ETDCC have an under utilised clubhouse during the winter months. Jags have conducted our Management meetings at the clubhouse and also held our 2009 Winter Registrations at ETDCC. ETDCC need additional hard wickets and we need netball courts. The linking of two premier sporting clubs in the same complex is an exciting development.

A development on this scale requires major funding. A proposal will be presented to government and council for funding submissions. Other proposed means of funding will be fund-raising events, sponsorship, donations and fees.

The Jags community is very excited by this concept and look forward to having Newton Jaguars Netball clubrooms, courts and a home.
