Fees:

The fee structure for the 2022 is different. Previously, players would pay a registration fee to the club which would include the Netball SA membership fee and paid by the club on behalf of the player.

With the introduction of the Play HQ system. The Netball SA membership fee is charged separately to our club fees. In 2022, the Netball SA membership fees including GST are as follows:

Seniors (18 and older) - \$123.46

Juniors (7 to 17) - \$ 95.40

NJNC Management Committee has set club fees for the 2022 season as follows:

Sub Primary - \$270

Primary, Sub Junior & Junior – \$300

Intermediate – \$390

Seniors - \$360

Upon registration, there is a small Australian Netball Digital Services Fee and Play HQ administration fee.

SA Sports Government Vouchers

Government Sports Voucher are able to be applied against the Netball SA membership for players aged between 5-15 years (2007-2017).

Click on 'Have a voucher?' enter the required details and click apply. NOTE - only one voucher can be claimed per year and the year of schooling is for the 2022 school year.
